INSTALLATION:

If your barrel threads are longer than .625 in or you can visually see barrel threads when the silencer is attached, please install the provided spacer for proper fit.



DISASSEMBLY:

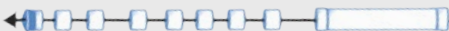
⚠ BEFORE REMOVING ANY SILENCER FROM ITS HOST FIREARM, REMOVE THE MAGAZINE FROM YOUR FIREARM, MAKE SURE THE BOLT OR SLIDE IS LOCKED TO THE REAR AND THE FIREARM IS UNLOADED BY PERFORMING A PHYSICAL AND VISUAL INSPECTION OF CHAMBER AND MAGAZINE WELL.

1. Remove silencer from firearm.
2. Remove the front end cap of the silencer with a standard 1/2 in socket in a counter-clockwise direction. ⚠ WARNING - DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REMOVE REAR END CAP FROM SILENCER.

DIASSEMBLY:



3. Orient front of the silencer down and remove 7 baffles from the tube.



CLEANING & MAINTENANCE:

▲ DO NOT USE METAL TOOLS FOR CLEANING.

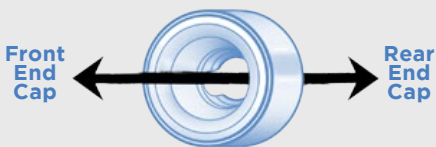
▲ NOTE: Q, LLC RECOMMENDS CLEANING YOUR SILENCER EVERY 1,000 ROUNDS.

▲ AS WITH ALL FIREARMS MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING, ALWAYS WEAR PROPER PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT.

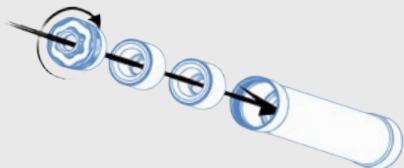
Using a piece of solvent-moistened Scotch-Brite™ or a nylon brush, clean carbon deposits from baffles, tube, and front cap.

ASSEMBLY:

1. Insert the baffles into the silencer tube with concave sides of baffles facing toward the front of the silencer, in any order, as shown below.



2. Reattach the front end cap clockwise using a standard 1/2 inch socket with no more than 50 in-lbs torque.
▲ USE CARE NOT TO CROSS THREAD.



3. Silencer assembly is complete. Reattach silencer to firearm and enjoy!
